Children have a lot to **do** before they enter school.

Parents are the key to helping their children learn, grow and get ready for school.



The **Watch Me Grow** program can help parents help their children get ready for school by providing **free** developmental and social screenings to children 0-5 years.

Parents learn valuable information about their child's social and developmental skills. Families can learn about other community programs that they may be eligible for.

Visits will take place at the family's home, or at another community setting, based on the wishes of the family. Any child participating in the **Watch Me Grow** program will be eligible for free follow-up screenings and visits until they enter Kindergarten.

Currently this program is available to ALL children who live in the "Zone" – the designated school readiness area of Sonoma County. This includes the Burbank, Brook Hill, Lehman, Lincoln, Meadow View, Roseland and Sheppard elementary school catchment areas. Any child who lives, attends preschool or goes to childcare in these areas is eligible for this free program.
